Dear Chief Monahan:

Pursuant to our conversation yesterday, the Volusia County Sheriff's Office is prepared to provide dispatch services for the City of Port Orange Police and Fire Departments for a cost of \$685,257 for the first year. Our contracts are three years in length and provide for an annual increase of no more than 5%. This increase is for personnel services only, i.e. insurance adjustments, pay raises and retirement. At the end of the three-year contract, any cost adjustments that have not been covered by the above mentioned increase would be caught up during the next contract negotiation.

The City of Port Orange will be responsible for all radio equipment and MDC's, including replacement and repairs. We will provide CAD data to you; however, it will be your responsibility to interface it into your RMS.
